GUIDELINES

1. The dance entry must depict Visayan culture and tradition.
2. Concept or theme for costumes and performance are left to the discretion of the participants based on their own interpretation of what is relevant to "KAUGMARAN".
3. Dance steps, costumes, accessories and equipment of the dance should be in context of the chosen theme or concept.
4. Dance steps, body movements and costumes should conform with the normal standard of morality and conduct.
5. Only one music shall be used (recorded) to be provided by the organizing committee.
6. Order of the street dance and dance performance shall be drawn by lots.
7. Parade dance steps should be progressive all throughout the parade route. This is to facilitate the smooth flow of the parade. Five (5) points shall be deducted from the total score of any contingent who violates this provision.
8. Performance shall be limited to ten (10) minutes including the entrance and exit to be performed at the athletic oval. A penalty of five (5) points from the total score shall be imposed against any contingent who violates this provision.
9. Props on the parade route should be of moderate size (not more than 10 ft. in height, width – 8 ft.) and design to allow viewing of the spectators and judges.
10. Participating groups who will perform and use costumes and props of the Sinulog, Maskara, Dinagyang, Pintados and others is automatically disqualified.
11. The use of flammable materials such as fireworks or pyrotechnics as part of the show are strictly prohibited. A five (5) point deduction shall be imposed against any contingent who violates this provision.
12. The composition of the contingent must be within the minimum of forty (40) and a maximum of sixty (60) mixed with students, faculty and staff.
13. Each contingent must be properly identified with rectangular placard (W-2 ft., L-3 ft.) showing the name of the college/centers, offices and institutes.
14. The final decision of the KAUGMARAN board of judges shall be FINAL and UNAPPEALABLE.
