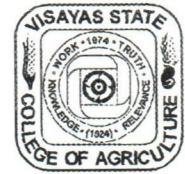

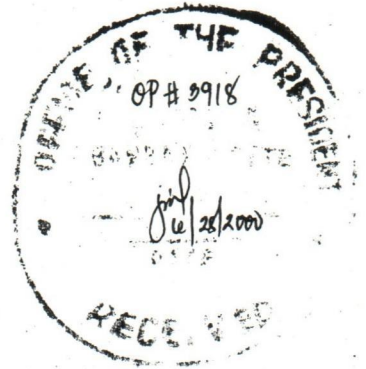

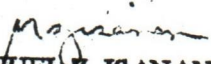

**11<sup>th</sup> National Statistics Month Celebration**

**TO :** President, State Colleges and Universities

Supt., Carigara College of Fisheries

1. In observance of Presidential Proclamation No. 647, "Declaring the Month of October of every year is the National Statistics Month", all Higher Education Institutions, both public and private, are enjoined to support and participate in this month-long celebration.
2. The aim for this year's celebration is "to highlight the importance of gender statistics in planning and decision making" hence the theme, "Empowering Filipino Women Through Gender Statistics".
3.
