R E: Reconstitution of the VSU Administrative Scholarship Committee

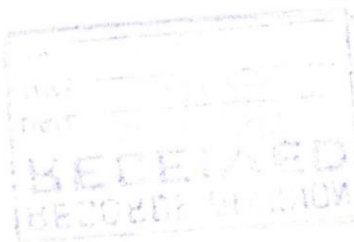
