- 1. Plan and coordinate the conduct of assessments in their respective assigned offices in coordination with the University Risk Manager to define and analyze possible risks (financial, legal, security, health, and others) the university may encounter.
- 2. Review and evaluate the gravity of each risk by considering its consequences in their assigned offices.
- 3. In their assigned offices, identify potential risk exposures, recommend solutions, implement approved programs, promote loss prevention, and update and monitor compliance of government statutory and regulatory provisions.
- 4. Develop risk management controls and systems and design processes to eliminate or mitigate potential risks in their respective offices.
- 5. Prepare reports and present recommendations to the University Risk Manager.
- 6. Do other tasks related to risk management in their assigned offices.

Moreover, they are entitled to the privileges granted and the responsibilities attached to the position subject to pertinent policies.
