In compliance with CHED Memorandum Order No. 1, series of 2015 on "Establishing the Policies and Guidelines on Gender and Development in the CHED and HEIs", the Visayas State University has established its GAD Focal Point System (GFPS). To enable the GFPS especially the Technical Working Group to function effectively, members undergo capacity development on the three basic GAD Modules stipulated by the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW): (1) Gender Sensitivity Training++, (2) Gender Analysis, and (3) GAD Planning and Budgeting.

The GST++ will focus on core GAD concepts, gender analysis, gender mainstreaming tools such as the Gender Mainstreaming Evaluation Framework (GMEF) and the Harmonized Gender and Development Guidelines.
