Dear Ma'am.

Good day!

I am writing to inform you of a concerning increase in chickenpox cases in our community. As of September 24, we have documented a total of 13 cases, with nine of these involving Grade 9 students from VSUIHS. Varicella, also known as chickenpox, is an airborne disease, making it highly contagious. Therefore, it is crucial that we take proactive measures to prevent further spread within the school and the community.

To address this situation, we recommend temporarily suspending face-to-face classes and shifting to online learning of Grade 9-Diamond to limit exposure. Additionally, we suggest the following actions:

- 1. Wearing Face Masks: Encourage the use of face masks to help reduce transmission.
- 2. Vaccination: Promote vaccination for unvaccinated students as soon as possible.
- 3. **Information Dissemination:** Ensure proper communication of information regarding chickenpox to both students and parents.
- 4. **Health Protocols:** Implement any necessary health protocols such as proper disinfection of classrooms to effectively manage this outbreak.
