Administrative Flow in Dealing with Student Misbehavior

Effective immediately, the attached definition of Jurisdiction and Administrative Flow in Dealing with Student Misbehavior shall be followed.

In this regard, the OSA and the various academic departments are requested to organize their respective Committees on Student Discipline, and inform this office and the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs regarding their membership not to exceed five (5), but not less than three (3). OSA guidance counsellors and departmentbased guidance facilitators shall be excluded from membership in said committee in order not to interfere with their counselling functions.
