III. INSTRUCTIONS

A. General Instructions

- 1. All graduating students must attend the rehearsals punctually.
- 2. Graduating students must bring and wear their graduation attire exactly as during the commencement ceremony for the final rehearsal to ensure proper protocol adherence.
- 3. Graduating students participating in Pasidungog 2024 may bring up to two (2) parents/guardians/guests.
- 4. For Commencement Exercises, all graduating students must adhere to the following attire guidelines:
 - Female: Sleeved/sleeveless/off-shouldered dresses; closed shoes with heels (minimum 1 inch).

Page 2 of 5 FM-VSU-02 V3 06-06-2024 Male: Long sleeves with necktie; black slacks/formal black pants; formal black shoes with white socks.

Attire restrictions include no jeans, casual pants, long/ball gowns, t-shirts/polo shirts, dresses/skirts longer than the toga, light or bright-colored shoes, and big dangling earrings.

Escorts of the graduating students must also dress appropriately.

- 5. Three (3) parents/guardians/guests per student will be allowed inside the VSU Gymnasium. Guests must show their tickets to gain entry into the gymnasium.
- 6. The commencement exercises will commence promptly as scheduled.
- Only the official commencement photographer may take photos near the stage. Personal photography is permitted from seats without flash or tripods, ensuring minimal disruption to others.
- 8. Noisemakers, signs, and throwing of confetti are strictly prohibited during the ceremonies.
- 9. Graduating students under the influence of alcohol are not permitted to attend.
- 10. Dormitory accommodations are available for parents and guests.
- 11. Please bring your own tumblers; use of disposable plastic bottles is discouraged.
- 12. Gift-giving, money garlands/leis, and wearing corsages during the ceremony are prohibited.
- 13. Cell phones must be switched off or in silent mode throughout the ceremony.
- 14. The CLAYGO (Clean As You Go) policy must be observed at all times.
- 15. Long hair and facial hair must be neat and tidy.
- 16. Academic gowns are to be worn closed at the front.
- 17. Toga and ticket distribution will follow the schedule:

- Graduating students must bring any Valid ID when claiming their toga, program and tickets.
- Graduating students are required to allocate the following amount for their graduation toga. This amount covers the rental fee and a refundable deposit. The deposit will be reimbursed upon the return of the toga to the University.

- Graduates should return the toga at the VSU Infirmary immediately after the commencement and/or the following day after the commencement exercises. Failure to do so will result in payment of a late return or lost toga penalty fee.
- Graduating students who will not be able to personally claim their toga on the scheduled date can send a representative. The authorized representative must present the following: 1) a letter of authorization signed by the student; 2) a photocopy of the student's valid ID bearing the student's photo and signature; 3) original and photocopy of the authorized representative's valid ID.

B. Parking and Traffic Flow

- 1. Faculty and staff with vehicles will receive a vehicle pass.
- 2. Graduating students with vehicles must obtain a vehicle pass from the security office, to be displayed prominently on the vehicle dashboard.
- 3. Shuttle service will be available for graduates, parents, and guests at designated points.
- 4. One-way traffic will be enforced on campus.

C. VSU Commencement Exercises Marshalls, Readers & Graduation Focal Persons (GFP)

- 1. Marshalls, Readers, and Graduation Focal Persons are required to attend the commencement exercises rehearsals.
- 2. GFP are responsible for assisting in organizing students in their designated seats during the rehearsal schedule of their department/college.
- 3. Marshalls are responsible for creating seating plans and managing traffic flow of the graduation ceremony.
- 4. Readers are tasked with familiarizing themselves with the correct pronunciation of each graduating student's name.
