R E: Suspension of both work and classes from April 12-13, 2022

Considering the damage brought by Tropical Storm Agaton to Baybay City and our neighboring towns, I am declaring suspension of both work and classes from April 12-13, 2022 at the VSU Main Campus.

This order does not cover our crisis and disaster frontliners including key university officials, security personnel, medical workers and our employees in charge of repair and maintenance of our power and water utilities.

Our component campuses in Alangalang, Isabel, Tolosa, and Villaba shall follow the declaration of their respective local government units (LGUs).

We have already secured our students living inside our dormitories and have evacuated some of our staff in pre-identified academic buildings to ensure their safety and the safety of their loved ones.

Please continue to pray for VSU, for Baybay City and the rest of our surrounding municipalities as we recover from the many challenges brought by Tropical Storm Agaton.

We also advise everyone who are living in critical danger zones near waterways including those that are located in landslide-prone areas to follow preemptive evacuation as massive rain is still forecasted to persist in the next two days.
