

Ma'am:

1. This has reference to our conference last 21 June 1996 regarding violation of VISCA Code committed by Mr Nilo M Jordan, an employee and student of VISCA.

2. Background:

Subject is a member of Tactical Officers of the VISCA ROTC unit and an occupant of VISCA ROTC Office as of School Year 1994 - 1995. Subject allowed by the undersigned to occupy the Admin NCO's quarter located at VISCA ROTC office as adviser and to supervise the cadet officers occupying the bed-space in maintaining the office and its surroundings.

3. Facts of the Case:

In the early part of summer 1996, the undersigned received reports that subject frequently allowing male and female visitors in his quarter, and sometime, such visitors are stayed overnight and use our office as their drinking place.

The undersigned who at that time in Camp Downes, Ormoc City, sent a letter to subject stating therein that such is prohibited and further gave warning that repetition of same offense will mean appropriate action.

The situation temporarily normalise, because semilar reports was received by the undersigned after a few weeks. Cursory investigation was conducted to cadet officers occupying the ROTC office and showed that the report is confirmed.


To further confirm the veracity of the report and the allegation of the cadet officers, I confronted with the subject in connection with the report and he further admitted the offense.

a. Subject was advise to transfer and given fifteen (15) days to look for another residence/Dormitory.


