**R E: Land Use and Development Committee**


By virtue of the authority vested in me by the VSU Board of Regents, you are hereby designated to constitute the VSU Land Use and Development Committee in lieu of the VSU Land Use and Survey Committee effective immediately until December 31, 2013 or unless sooner terminated or revoked by appropriate authorities.

The main functions of the committee are as follows:

- Assess the proper utilization of VSU lands including external campuses and identify land areas according to specific function/purpose;
- Coordinate in the conduct of relocation surveys of all VSU land boundaries in the main and external campuses initiated by the VSU Land Use and Survey Committee;

- Continue the evaluation of the accuracy of existing land monuments as reflected in the landmaps;
- Recommend to the President plans, programs, policies and actions on matters pertaining to land utilization, its security and boundaries in the main and external campuses;
- Oversee the implementation of policies and guidelines relative to VSU land utilization and development; and
- Perform other functions that may be assigned by the President.
