You are enjoined to attend a talk about "Aging: Lesson from a Tiny Worm" by an expert on Aging Physiology on August 15, 2018 (Wednesday) at 8:30 – 11:00 am at the Philrootcrops Training Hall.

Prof. Dr. Bart Braeckman is a renowned biochemist and physiologist from the University of Ghent, Belgium. He earned his teacher's degree for secondary education in Biology (magna cum laude) and completed both his masters and doctorate degrees (summa cum laude) at the University of Ghent. Recognized internationally for his research on aging physiology in the nematode Caenorhabditis elegans, he was the first to succeed in increasing the lifespan of C. elegans by sixfold. He has extensively studies the "from calorie restriction to the free radical theory" and "the metabolic rate theory in worms."
