- 3. Develop and implement standard operating procedures (SOPs) and quality assurance protocols to maintain the accuracy and reliability of analyses.
- 4. Supervise laboratory personnel, providing guidance, training, and performance evaluations to ensure high-quality outputs.
- 5. Coordinate with faculty, staff, students, and other external stakeholders to facilitate access to laboratory services and resources.
- 6. Ensure compliance with safety regulations, environmental standards, and hazardous waste disposal protocols in laboratory operations.
- 7. Oversee procurement and inventory management of laboratory supplies, reagents, and consumables.
- 8. Prepare and submit periodic reports on laboratory activities, including utilization, maintenance, and financial performance.
- 9. Foster collaborations with academic, research, and industry partners to expand laboratory services and capabilities.
- 10. Perform other tasks related to laboratory management as assigned by the Vice President for Research, Extension, and Innovation or the University President.
