R E: Visayas State University Committee on Advocates for Resilience and Empowerment of Students (VSU CARES)

In response to the Commission on Human Rights –VIII-ADV-2021-28F21 re: "Advisory on the Different Roles and Responsibilities of Government Agencies under the Mental Health Act" for State Universities and Colleges and all higher education institutions to "integrate age-appropriate content pertaining to mental health into the curriculum to all degree programs", the Visayas State University supports the integration of mental health, wellbeing and resilience of all students through the different learning areas of the curriculum, thus, as proposed by the Office of the Vice President for Student Affairs and Services (OVPSAS) a University Committee for Mental Health and Well-being called the Visayas State University Committee on Advocates for Resilience and Empowerment of Students (VSU CARES) is hereby created with the following functions:

- Work collaboratively with both teaching and non-teaching personnel in the identification of strategies, contribute to policies and operational practices;
- Demonstrate leadership and provide professional learning to others, such as teachers and other school personnel on concepts of resilience as gestures of empowerments;
- Coordinates with other departments/offices/units (including the Integrated High School and Student Support Services staff) and external service providers, where necessary, to provide support to students;
- Establish mechanism for strong mentoring system to provide peer positive reinforcement to students;
- Spearheads online counseling sessions in remote educational era for students to seek assistance from professional counselors and guidance advocates to get appropriate psychological support care;
- Capacitate faculty and students on concepts of resilience as gesture of empowerment and continued professional development activities; and
- Create relevant policies and programs/projects to ensure that both faculty and learners manifests a healthy mindset towards resilience.
