TO: All Faculty Members and Students

RE: Continuation of Classes and Work at ViSCA

All faculty members and students are hereby advised that classes and work in ViSCA shall proceed as usual. You should not give recognition to the call from the ViSCA Protest Movement who are only using you to reinforce their illegal mass action in order to achieve their objectives.

At this stage, the motives of the leaders of the ViSCA Protest Movement are already obvious after hiding for so long behind certain issues which have been properly attended to by the Administration, higher authorities, and the Courts. Nevertheless, there are many of the VPM members who are still rational and maintain to adhere to their basic principles and do not necessarily believe in the philosophies of their self-appointed leaders. These principled faculty and staff, just as the rest of the faculty and staff of ViSCA, have continued their allegiance to the College by performing their duties and responsibilities. Therefore, students should not make any assumption that classes will not be held by teachers whom they suspect as VPM-sympathizers.

Should any class be abandoned by the teacher, the Director of Instruction has been authorized to assign other teachers until the end of the semester. The replacements shall check attendance and assume the full responsibility of the class for the rest of the semester.

Likewise, all supervisors are advised to monitor their subordinates. No leaves shall be approved for personnel assign to the vital functions of the College such as those in Budget, Personnel, Accounting, Cash, Supply and Property, Electrical and Motor Pool.
