R E: Inclusion of Literature Courses in the Revised Curriculum

Please be informed that CHED issued CMO 4 s. 2018 just today, requiring the inclusion of literature subjects in the revised curricula, in addition to Filipino and Panitikan, as follows:

For fields related to Humanities, Social Sciences and Communication:

- * 9 units of Filipino (Fili 11, Fili 12, Fili 14)
- * 6 units of Literature (choose from the existing literature subjects offered by DLABS)

For other fields of study:

- * 6 units of Filipino (Fili 11 and Fili 12)
- * 3 units of Literature (Fili 14, since it is also a Literature course)

Academic departments whose curriculum proposals were already approved by the University Curriculum Committee are advised to incorporate this new requirement in your revised curricula. But if you have already reproduced 200 copies of the proposal for the UAC, just do it in the final copy of the proposal.
