Greetings of peace!

The Student Election Board, duly organized by the University Supreme Student Council Federation (USSCF) as a constitutional commission, that requires the board to facilitate elections as mandated by the Student Election Board Code, facilitated the recently concluded 2024 USSC and CSSC Election.

However, due to the failure of meeting the fifty percent plus one (50% + 1) quorum of the total population of VSU Students enrolled in the 2nd Semester of Academic Year 2023-2024, the election is considered null and void as stated in the SEB Board Resolution no. 4, s. 2023.

The SEB-Baybay hereby follows a mandate to conduct a re-election as deemed necessary by the board through the Board Resolution no. 5, s. 2024, the board had set an updated schedule for the USSC and CSSC Elections, with the election day scheduled on May 17, 2024, 08:00 a.m. to 08:00 p.m. The election will be in a form of face to face for both USSC and CSSC.
