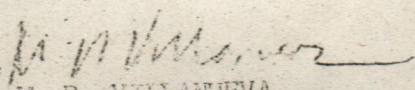

R E: Illegal Suspension of Classes

This is to inform all concerned that it is illegal for anyone to suspend classes without authorization from the CDI, OVPAA and the Office of the President. It is likewise illegal for government official to stage mass action or to take mass leave that will result in the disruption of government operations (Civil Service Memorandum Circular No. 6 s. 1987). Furthermore, it is illegal to intimidate and coerce students to participate in mass actions. All classes must be held in the normal places according to the schedule. The full force of the law will be applied accordingly to those who will continue to violate it.
