R E: Rewriting of VSU Code

The VSU Code is the "Mother Code" of the University. It captures in a short and concise form the structure, governance, and operations of the university. The detailed policies, guidelines, and procedures are contained in the various manuals, handbooks, Graduate School Code, and other documents.

In view of the changes in VSU's organizational structure in 2017 and in 2021, many of the provisions in the 2015 edition of the VSU Code are no longer applicable. In the January 27, 2023 meeting of the Top Management, it was agreed that the university shall come up with an updated version before the year ends.

The new edition of the Code will consist of the following parts, and the following offices will spearhead in coming up with the revisions of these parts, as indicated below:
