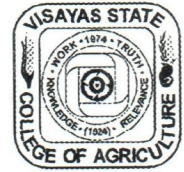

The application for Ship for Southeast Asian Youth Program (SSEAYP) is now open to interested applicants.

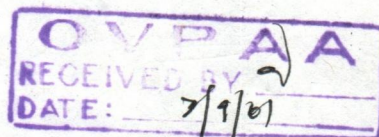
