R E: Identified Evacuation Sites at VSU During Typhoons

The Crisis Management Committee identified the following buildings as evacuation sites during typhoons/ flooding:

- 1. Department of Horticulture (DOH)

- 2. Eco-Farmi Building
- 3. OVPREI RDE Hall
- 4. PhilRootcrops Complex
- 5. Engineering Building Complex
- 6. Regional Climate Change Research and Development Center (RCCRDC)
- 7. Advanced Research Innovation Center (ARIC) Building
- 8. ADE/CME Building

- 9. VSU Library (New building)
- 10. Gymnatorium
- 11. Department of Liberal Arts and Behavioral Sciences (DLABS) Building
- 12. ODS Complex
- 13. College of Nursing Building
- 14. Old Library Building
- 15. College of Forestry Building
- 16. Department of Consumer and Hospitality Management (DCHM) Building

In this regard, concerned Deans, Heads, or in charge of the identified buildings are requested to always prepare their respective facilities as evacuation sites during typhoons or similar calamities. Particularly determine and prepare the evacuees' living quarters and comfort rooms for use. In addition, essential equipment and facilities should be protected and kept safe while the building is being used as an evacuation site.

The VSU Crisis Management Committee, the USHER, and the DRRMO will determine the number and assignment of the evacuees to the identified evacuation sites.

Faculty and staff who may opt to be evacuated may also use their respective offices as evacuation sites during the typhoon and should also coordinate with University DRRMO for monitoring.
