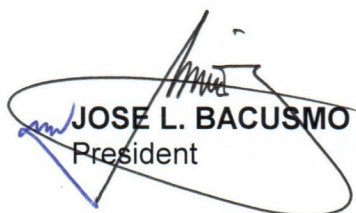

This office reiterates the provisions of Article III, Section 36, item c of RA 9165 otherwise known as *Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002* which states that "students of secondary and tertiary schools shall, pursuant to the related rules and regulations as contained in the school's student handbook and with notice to the parents, undergo a random drug testing, provided, that all drug testing expenses whether in public or private schools under this Section will be borne by the government". Hence, your support as members of the Selection board is enjoined.

SUBJECT: **NEW SCHEDULE OF CHED RANDOM DRUG TESTING
FOR TERTIARY STUDENTS**

DATE: July 9, 2010

In compliance with the implementation of the Random Drug Testing for Tertiary Students funded by the Dangerous Drugs Board, pursuant to CHED Memorandum Order No. 25, s. 2009, the agreement between Commission on Higher Education and Department of Health during a meeting held on June 29, 2010, all concerned are requested to prepare the schedule of random drug testing with the corresponding number of RDT teams for the remaining Higher Education Institution in your respective regions based on the attached 2010 CHED RDT Plan. Please submit the said schedule to the Office of Student Services on/or before July 19, 2010.

The Department of Health will provide seventeen (17) DOH Medical Analysts who will join the RDT team. As such, CHEDRO Drug Education Coordinators will lead the RDT Team during this activity in the Higher Education Institutions and the schedule for RDT will start at 9:00 AM or at 1:30 PM.

In view thereof, the remaining institutions for the RDT in your respective region are required to prepare and provide the following:

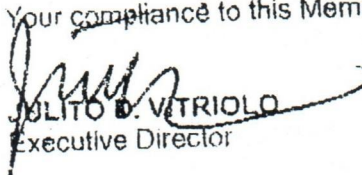
1. copies of the masterlist of students enrolled using the prescribed form in a cumulative order and submit the same through e-file and hard copies to the Office of Student Services prior to the scheduled conduct of the RDT;
2. conference area for the students' orientation;
3. area for the collection of urine sample with adjacent comfort rooms for male and female;
4. participation of the School Selection Board composed of the School Head as Chairperson; the Drug Testing Coordinator; the Faculty, Students and Parent Representatives as members.

The CHEDROs are likewise advised to coordinate with the Center for Health and Development (CHD-DOH) in your respective region for the transportation requirements to facilitate the conduct of RDT in the assigned areas.

This Office reiterates the provisions of Article III, Sec. 6, item c of the Republic Act 9165 which states that "students of secondary and tertiary schools shall, pursuant to the related rules and regulations as contained in the school's student handbook and with notice to the parents, undergo a random drug testing, provided, that all drug testing expenses whether in public or private schools under this Section will be borne by the government". Hence, full participation and cooperation of the Heads of the Higher Education Institutions and necessary preparations is hereby encouraged.
