The conduct of Bid Evaluation & Post-Qualification were put on hold pending the decision of the BOR of the BAC Resolution #69 Series of 2018, titled "BAC Resolution Finding Electrocomputer Data Systems for giving false additional information in its BoQ when it copied in toto the VSU specifications in addition to its offered brand and/or model but said action is not sufficient to warrant blacklisting since said false information has no bearing to BAC during the conduct of the post qualification and in making the decision to award and therefore, is recommending instead stern warning not to do the same in the future", which is the recommendation of the BAC on the first blacklisting complaint filed on November 5, 2018 by Baybay Printshop against EDS for the bidding no. GOODS-18-28. However, the BOR during its meeting on December 7, 2018, which was attended by Atty. Guinocor, was advised to proceed with the awarding of contracts of all projects bid out, which was put on hold due to the undecided BAC Resolution #69 S-2018.

## Mr. President,

I am writing this letter to clarify matters pertaining to the investigation to be conducted on BAC-2 Resolution No. 1, s. 2019 and BAC-1 Resolution No. 4, s. 2019, both of which are Blacklisting Complaints filed by Mr. Nello P. Roa IV against the Electrocomputer Data Systems (EDS) in the two (2) Bids and Awards Committees of the University.

Mr. President, please be informed that in the case of the bidding for BAC-2 GOODS-18-19 (Supply and Delivery of I.T. Equipment and Supplies), the BAC-2 verified that the EDS had "contracts but not yet awarded" with the VSU Main Campus as well as the Southern Leyte State University. Based on this non-disclosure which is part of the eligibility requirements for the Bidders on "Statement of On-Going Government and Private Contracts," the BAC-2 declared EDS ineligible and disqualified EDS from the bidding for BAC-2 GOODS-18-29.

On the other hand, in the case of the bidding for BAC-1 GOODS-18-33 (Supply and Delivery of I.T. Equipment and Supplies), the BAC-1 issued BAC-1 Resolution No. 4, s. 2019 dated 6 February 2019 which indicated in the 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph, to quote: "In the evaluation of Item No. 25 (UPS, Back-UPS, 750 VA), the BAC-1 found out that the offer of EDS, although the LCB is not responsive because the TWG informed the BAC that "WisePower" does not contain "Back-UPS" specifications, leading to the BAC-1 decision to declare failure of bidding of the particular item due to non-conformance to the required specifications."

Mr. President, during the 92<sup>nd</sup> BOR Meeting held at the CHED Central Office last 12 July 2019, Regent Milo D. Delos Reyes, motioned that the two Blacklisting Complaints filed by Mr. Nello P. Roa IV against EDS be remanded for Investigation by the University President before it is lodged with the Board. The motion was unanimously approved by the Governing Board.

As yet, this Office has not received any order from the Governing Board that the said investigation has been delegated to other parties.

I am furnishing your Office a copy of all the documentation pertaining to BAC-2 Resolution No. 1. s. 2019 as well as BAC-1 Resolution No. 4, s. 2019 in conformity with the BOR decision to remand the Investigation to the University President.

Hoping that you find everything in order.
