**R E: Composition of the CPES (Constructors Performance Evaluation System)
Implementing Unit**

In reference to Section 12.3 of Annex E of the 2016 RIRR of Republic Act No. 9184, "All Procuring Entities implementing infrastructure projects are required to establish CPES Implementing Units (IUs) in their respective offices/agencies/corporations." With Engr. Marcelo T. Abrera, Jr. as the Unit Supervisor, please constitute yourselves to compose the CPES Implementing Unit of the university effective immediately until 31 December 2023 or unless sooner revoked or terminated by higher authorities.

The following are the duties and responsibilities of the CPES Implementing Unit:

1. Implement CPES in VSU infrastructure projects in compliance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its IRR;
2. Oversee and ensure efficient and effective implementation of CPES in infrastructure projects;
3. Submit CPES reports to the PDCB within the prescribed time;
4. Undertake CPES evaluation based on the CPES Implementing Guidelines for Infrastructure Projects (all necessary tests, verifications/ validations, etc. must be done).
5. Observe confidentiality of CPES evaluation findings and recommendations; and
6. Submit CPES evaluation reports and other reportorial requirements as may be required, within five (5) days after completion of CPES evaluation;
