R E: USE OF EXPLOSIVES ON CAMPUS

Many individuals and families complained regarding the recent explosion of firecrackers on campus at about 5:00 o' clock in the morning of July 13, 1988. It is not difficult to figure out why the members of our community are quite concerned about explosions, particularly when it is hard to distinguish some firecrackers from gunfire.

Effective immediately, therefore, the use of firecrackers and other explosive materials is banned on campus except when used as a part of officially authorized and college-wide programs and during Christmas and New Year Seasons. Any violation of this directive can be considered as ground for administrative sanction. The Security Office is hereby authorized to implement this directive.
