R E: Unauthorized Posting of Placards and Billboards

In accordance with the ViSCA Code Section 127, 0.P. Memo No. 22, s. 1987, the pertinent provisions of PD 1096, and the authority granted to ViSCA by the Department of Public Works and Highways "to maintain the road shoulders and canals of the highway traversing ViSCA, including the proper implementation of the laws, rules and regulations pertinent to the placement of billboards, signs and posters", all placards, bulletin boards, and posters that block the view of motorists and pedestrians, obstruct the natural view of the landscape, and posted without permission from the Office of the ViSCA President shall be removed and impounded.

If impounded placards are not claimed by their rightful owners within five (5) days, they shall be disposed in a manner that ViSCA may deem fit.

It is not the intention of the College to infringe on the rights of any person or group to use placards/posters as a means of legitimate protest, but their use must not violate existing laws, and College rules and regulations.
