Dear Dr. Tulin:

This is a comment to what appears to be an anomalous deed perpetrated by a part-time instructor in the Department of Liberal Arts & Behavioral Sciences (DLABS).

To set the matters straight, a Permit to conduct make-up classes was filed and secured by the instructor concerned for the period July 25 and 26, 2015. However, the instructor failed to come on the scheduled dates.

While attendance to scheduled make-up classes may not be very compulsory on the part of the instructor concerned (as he may advance and feign valid reasons for his absence), however, the duly approved Permit should not be used to justify in filling-up the Daily Time Record (DTR). The law provides that the DTR shall be filled-up in accordance with the actual service rendered in relation to the duly approved workload. Please find Permits and DTR for July 2015 hereto attached and marked as Annex "A", Annex "B", and Annex "C", respectively. A perusal of Annex "C" would reveal that he has rendered services on July 25 (Saturday) and July 26 (Sunday). This coincides with Annex "A" and Annex "B". However, in July 25 (marked as Annex "C-1"), his service started at 7am until 12 noon which is contrary to what is reflected in Annex "A" which is from 2-3pm and 3-4pm. Consequently, his total number of hours rendered for that particular day is seven (&) hours as against the approved number of hours which is two (2) hours. What makes the matter worst is the fact that he never conducted make-up classes on said dates.

Dishonesty, by the way, is a grave offense. The same is punishable by dismissal under Civil Service Rules. Also, the concerned part-time instructor may be held liable under Article 19 of the New Civil Code (NCC), to wit: "Ever person must, in the exercise of his rights and in the performance of his duties, act with justice, give everyone his due, and observe honesty and good faith". In failing to perform his duty, he did not give everyone his due; in filling-up his DTR on the dates he did not render actual service, he did not observe honesty and the same was done not in good faith.

Students will not come in the open to complain for the absence or non-appearance of the instructor (during make-up classes) for obvious reason/s.

I hope the appropriate committee shall conduct a thorough and an impartial investigation on this matter and appropriate sanctions be meted for such malfeasance and misfeasance.

COMPLAINT AFFIDAVIT

I, NICOMEDES R. BORINES, Filipino, of legal age, married, with residence at Brgy. Candadam, Baybay City, Leyte hereby files this administrative complaint for **Dishonesty, Grave Misconduct** and **Falsification of Official Document** against the following persons:

- 1. ANNIE P. GRAVOSO Dept. Of Liberal Arts and Behavioral Sciences (DLABS) of VSU; and
- 2. ALVIN I. ALBALADEJO Part-time Instructor of DLABS of VSU

The complaint is based on the following facts:

Prior to July 25, 2015, Permits to Move Class Outside of Regular Schedule was filed by and issued to Mr. ALVIN I. ALBALADEJO for the following subjects: Life and Works of Rizal (ScSc-16) and Philippine History (ScSc-15). Please find Annex "A" and Annex "B", respectively, hereto attached. The foregoing Permits were duly approved by the proper authorities of VSU. Please refer to Annex "A-1", "A-2", "A-3", and "A-4" of Annex "A"; and, Annex "B-1", "B-2", "B-3" and "B-4" of Annex "B". Thus, in the Daily Time Record (DTR) for the month of July 2015, a copy of which is hereto attached and marked as Annex "C", submitted to Dr. ANNIE P. GRAVOSO (department head), corresponding entries were made thereon with respect to time of arrival and time of departure in the 25th and 26th (Saturday and Sunday), respectively. A close perusal of the approved permit, specifically Annex "A" hereof, would indicate absence of request to hold make-up classes during the morning of July 25, 2015. However, Mr. Albaladejo made it appear that he conducted make-up classes in the morning of July 25 for five (5) consecutive hours by placing entries thereon. Consequently, his total contact hours allegedly rendered for that particular day is seven (7) hours instead of two (2) hours as approved in the foregoing permit. Hence, the entries made thereon (July 25) do not coincide with what is reflected in Annex "A". What makes the matter worst is the fact that he allegedly never conducted makeup classes on the dates specified in the permits. Please take note that part-time instructors are compensated based on actual contact hours rendered. Such contact hours are reflected in the Daily Time Record duly accomplished by the person concerned and submitted to the department head for further certification. The law provides that filling-up the DTR must be done in all honesty and in good faith. In this case, DR. ANNIE P. GRAVOSO in the DTR submitted by Mr. Alvin I. Albaladejo, jointly and severally "certified on her honor that the entry made therein is a true and correct report on the hours performed made daily at the time of arrival(s) and departure(s)". Please see Annex "C-2" in Annex "C" hereto attached. Dr. Gravoso affixed her signature to pervert the truth in spite of the manifest discrepancy noticeable in the documents. The issuance of such certification is related to or connected with the performance of the official function and duties attached to her office as such. Dr. Annie P. Gravoso knew of this incident as it was complainant who orally informed her based on feedbacks complainant received from students concerned. But, instead of conducting a thorough verification on the information, Dr. Gravoso advised Mr. Albaladejo: (1) to deny the existence of such malfeasance/misfeasance; (2) to produce a statement from the students concerned and to be signed by them that such information is not true; and, (3) to ask the Personnel Department to adjust his compensation (deducting the amount corresponding to the time involved in the controversy) to whatever amount he may receive in the month thereafter. One may only speculate that there could be collusion between the two (2) persons complained of based on the foregoing facts and circumstances. Dr. Gravoso may have previously known of similar deeds of Mr. Albaladejo in the past or she may have received benefits, pecuniary or otherwise, from the deed such that she never did anything to arrest the situation. Further, the intent to misled and cover-up the anomaly is expressly shown recommendation/endorsement forwarded to the Academic Personnel Board (APB) by DLABS where she was the department head, rehiring said part-time instructor for the second semester of school year 2015-2016. Please find Annex "D" hereto attached.

PRAYER

In view of the foregoing, it is respectfully prayed that the above-named persons complained of be charged administratively for Dishonesty, Grave Misconduct, and Falsification of Official Document.
