R E: Pet Dogs and Other Domesticated Animals in Campus

This office has been in receipt of numerous complaints regarding the continued proliferation of stray dogs and other domesticated animals within the faculty and student housing areas of the university.

The efforts of the College of Veterinary Medicine to catch stray animals are not enough to contain this recurring problem. Many untoward accidents have been reported on account of these stray animals.

Please be informed that it is a housing policy that households with pet dogs and cats must ensure that these animals are taken cared of and that these be confined within the premises of their homes. Failure to do so may be a basis for the revocation of housing privileges.

All faculty, staff and students in possession of pet animals are immediately directed to leash and/or cage these pets to ensure the safety of all residents.

Strict compliance of this directive is enjoined.
