Dear Pres. Milan:

This is in response to your note received by the undersigned to investigate the alleged issues raised by the PCC Director relative to the establishment of Transmission post incurring damages during the operation. Please be informed that an ocular inspection and investigation has been conducted immediately, and found out that said damages caused by the hauling of the concrete post and the installation was done since first week of March 2005 yet. The damages of the **napier grasses and the corn** can no longer be determine because the napier grass has recovered already and the corn have been already harvested, the same thing to the damages of the earth road caused by the hauling of the concrete post can no longer be determine, and finally the concrete post was already installed.

To determine the amount of damages is already impossible because of the aforementioned reason. And we should be reminded that payment of the damages incurred by the TransCo during the establishment of the Trans-Co Tower were already been made and accepted.

Lastly we hope that considering the operation as well as agreement between LSU and TransCo has been closed, the Security Office must be warn or be given an order not to allow anymore any person using the name of TransCo to enter into our campus to avoid similar cases as we experience today.
