



1. Per CHED Regional Memorandum No. 69, s. 1997 dated December 1, 1997, concerned schools are requested to submit the documents to support the application for Potential Center of Excellence (PCE).
2. The Commission on Higher Education requires that the regional nominee for PCE for agriculture education be submitted to the Office of Program and Standards, CHED Central Office for indorsement to the Technical Panel for Agricultural Education not later than March 15, 1998.
3. In order for the HERO VIII to meet the above deadline, the application together with the accomplished Quality Profile, PCE Checklist and other necessary documentary attachments should be submitted to this Office on or before February 15, 1998.
4. Only schools with application with the necessary supporting documents will be considered and subjected to the evaluation and selection process.
5. Application for the PCE in Agriculture Education should be by program basis, hence, a school may submit more than one (1) application depending on the program it would want to be identified as PCE. Information data provided should be program specific, e.g. enrollment and graduates for the past five (5) years, Board examination results, books, faculty, laboratory equipment, research, community services/extension, for Agriculture.
6. Please refer to CHED Memorandum Order No. 48, s. 1997 (Guidelines for the Identification, Support and Development of Potential Centers of Excellence (COEs) in Agriculture Education) which was inclosed in the CHED Regional Memorandum No. 69, s. 1997.
7. Immediate compliance of this CHED Regional Memorandum is desired.
