SUBJECT:

PROHIBITION AGAINST PARTISAN POLITICAL ACTIVITY/CAMPAIGN

DURING THE NATIONAL ELECTION ON MAY 14, 2001

To ensure the holding of a free, orderly, honest and credible election on May 14, 2001, all government employees are enjoined not to participate or engage in any partisan political activity or take part in any election except to vote nor shall they use their official authority or influence to coerce the political activity of any other person or body.

It is understood that no one is prohibited from expressing his views on current political problems or issues or from mentioning the names of his candidates for public offices whom he supports.
