The local government unit (LGU) of Baybay City through the Honorable City Mayor Jose Carlos L. Cari issued Executive Order No. 103 **"AN EXECUTIVE ORDER PRESCRIBING A QUICK RESPONSE (QR) CODE SYSTEM FOR CONTACT TRACING AND AS MEANS TO PREVENT AND/OR MITIGATE THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 IN THE CITY"** last April 15, 2021 which will take effect starting May 1, 2021. Thus, the University will strictly implement the provisions of EO No. 103 of LGU Baybay upon its effectivity specifically Section 1 of said EO. Thus, everyone is required to apply for a Baybay City (BC) Pass QR Code. All application both for personal, business, offices and other establishments QR Codes can be accessed through the BC Pass online registration portal at <https://bcpass.baybaycity.gov.ph>. Starting May 1, 2021, no person shall be allowed to enter the University without presenting a personal BC Pass for scanning by authorized personnel at the gates.

I urge everyone to be more vigilant and disciplined to follow the minimum health protocol the imposed by LGU-Baybay and University authorities. Let us all be part of the solution to this health crisis.
