R E: Aftermath of Typhoon "Rufing"


As you have witnessed, Typhoon "Rufing" inflicted serious damage on campus paralyzing our power supply, ripping off roof, windows and walls of buildings, destroying crops and causing injuries to some. The concerned offices have assessed the damage on structures and emergency measures are being undertaken to prevent further damage.

Due to limited resources, all unit heads are requested to extend full assistance in the rehabilitation work - at least to attend to security and repair needs of your respective units using resources available at your level. The Administration has prepared a package request for DBM, but this is not expected to come soon. Meanwhile, basic construction materials are being procured on emergency purchase.

According to GSO personnel, rehabilitation work on campus electricity will take time. Certain sectors of the campus may be energized in about two weeks, barring technical problems.

Priority for construction materials - new and used - shall be given to campus structures. Outside requests may be entertained on case to case basis depending on availability. Assistance can be extended in the form of civic action - preferably outside office hours. The College Calamity and Disaster Council shall take the responsibility in planning such program.
