Dear Dr. Tulin;

We would like to inform you that the NALAPO-ERECON of Japan will conduct an International Volunteer Training on Rainforestation from March 23 <sup>rd</sup> to March 29th, 2016 in Leyte, Philippines with the collaboration of Visayas State University through the Institute of Tropical Ecology and Environmental Management. Last August 2015, MOU between VSU through ITEEM (the originator of Rainforestation Technology) and ERECON was already signed.

The training will be funded by the National Land Afforestation Promotion Organization (NALAPO), Japan and implemented by ERECON. NALAPO was founded in Japan during 1950 that promotes national land afforestation campaign as a public movement. Whereas, ERECON, was founded also in Japan during 2000, which is a non-government and profit international organization whose aim is to contribute to the sustainable use of natural resources in Asian countries. So far, International Volunteer Training with NALAPO had been conducted four times already in Thailand, Cambodia and Philippines (Bohol).

This training primarily aims to expose ten Japanese trainees about the importance of reforestation and afforestation, in the face of global environmental pressures. We will also invite ten students from VSU to give them an opportunity to learn together with the Japanese and enhance cross-cultural experience and understanding with each other. We expect that this training would strengthen the environmental and cultural friendship between the both countries to achieve sustainable development in the future.

With the help of VSU, we will have lectures, visit rainforestation sites and conduct reforestation activity. ERECON will cover the transportation expenses for the VSU students for this training in Leyte. Our schedule during the visit is attached to this letter.
