

August 21, 1986 is not a holiday. President Cory Aquino has indicated no intention to declare the date as a holiday although it will be remembered as the third death anniversary of her husband, former Sen. Benigno S. Aquino, Jr.

However, MECS Minister Lourdes R. Quisumbing has said (Inquirer Aug. 15, 1986) that there will be no classes on August 21 in all levels, but students and teachers will participate in special ceremonies commemorating the death anniversary of the late Sen. Aquino and to remember the February Revolution.

In this connection, all student leaders and advisers are encouraged to make plans for the occasion for their respective organizations following the pronouncement of Minister Quisumbing. On the other hand, the Chief Librarian, with assistance from the Office of the Director of Instruction and the Director of Student Affairs, and the Officers of the College Supreme Student Council, is requested to set up an exhibit in the Library to commemorate the death of Sen. Aquino and the February Revolution.
