R E: REITERATION ON THE STRICT IMPLEMENTATION AND ADOPTION OF LGU-BAYBAY POLICIES ON CURFEW, BACKRIDERS IN MOTORCYCLES, AND CHILDREN (0 TO 20 YEARS OLD), ELDERLY (65 YEARS OLD AND ABOVE) DURING THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE PERIOD AGAINST COVID-19

The VSU Administration reiterates the strict implementation and adoption of the following LGU-Baybay City policies in relation to the mitigation of the transmission of CoVID-19:

- Curfew – The curfew from 9:00pm up to 5:00am shall continue to be imposed on all residents and persons in the city (per Executive Order No. 58 dated April 15, 2020 of the City Mayor of the City of Baybay, Leyte)
- “No backrider/s in motorcycles policy” by the Department of Transportation’s (DOTr) in response to health authorities’ call for the public to practice social and physical distancing. In support of their efforts against CoVID19, frontliners of the city shall be exempted from this policy (per Executive Order No. 60 dated April 23, 2020 of City Mayor of the City of Baybay, Leyte).

The frontliners of the university (health workers and security guards) are required to secure a “Frontline Pass” from the LGU-Baybay City for identification purposes.

- Children (0 to 20 years old), elderly (65 years old and above), and people with high-risk health issues are prohibited from leaving their homes at all times except for seeking medical attention (per Executive Order No. 58 dated April 15, 2020 of the City Mayor of the City of Baybay, Leyte).

VSU Security Office is directed to assist on the strict enforcement of these policies/measures.
