RE: Lifting of Classes and Work Suspension on October 23-25, 2024

Based on the latest weather forecasts and assessments done by the Department of Meteorology, in coordination with PAGASA, Tropical Storm "Kristine" is moving away from Eastern Visayas, and the weather is expected to improve gradually starting tomorrow, October 23, 2024. After considering the recommendations from the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs (OVPAA) and the VSU Incident Command System (ICS), the following guidelines are issued regarding the resumption of classes and work:

- 1. The suspension of work will be lifted effective tomorrow, October 23, 2024, as weather conditions become more manageable. Everyone is expected to resume their regular duties.
- 2. On October 23, 2024, face-to-face classes will be suspended, with all lecture sessions shifting to online or asynchronous modality to ensure the continuity of learning to provide flexibility for students who have already traveled home and may not yet be able to return to campus. Face-to-face classes will resume on October 24-25, 2024. However, laboratory classes may be held face-to-face.

We appreciate everyone's understanding and cooperation during this time. The safety and well-being of the VSU academic community remain our top priority, and these measures aim to ensure a smooth transition back to regular operations.
