In line with our Centennial celebration, we are implementing the following changes to our class schedules next week:

- All classes from VSU Baybay will transition to online or offline instruction from April 24-25, 2024 and April 27, 2024 (NSTP). This is to accommodate our alumni who will be utilizing the classrooms for the Alumni Homecoming activities.
- 2. Students from all campuses participating in the Grand Kaugmaran Festival Showdown and Street Dancing are excused from their classes from **April 24-25**, **2024 and April 27**, **2024 (NSTP)**.
- 3. All classes from all campuses will be suspended on **April 26, 2024** to allow faculty, staff, and students to participate in the Centennial Grand Parade and Convocation.

While synchronous classes are preferred, faculty members may make the appropriate arrangements and conduct classes asynchronously when applicable and for practical reasons.

This memo supersedes **OP Memo no. 71 regarding Shift to Flexible Learning**, hence deemed null and void.

Additionally, all drivers, pedestrians, and attendees are enjoined to follow traffic authorities and adhere to traffic regulations, pursuant to **OP Memo # 72 series of 2024 regarding traffic flow management for the centennial celebration** to ensure safety and security for all.
