In this regard, concerned Deans, Heads, or In-charge of the identified buildings are requested to always prepare their respective facilities as evacuation sites during typhoons or similar calamities. Particularly, you are requested to determine and prepare the evacuees' living quarters and comfort rooms for use and ensure adequate water supply. In addition, essential equipment and facilities should be protected and kept safe while the building is being used as an evacuation site.

The VSU Crisis Management Committee, the USHER, and the DRRMO will determine the number and assignment of the evacuees to the identified evacuation sites.

Faculty and staff who may opt to be evacuated may also use their respective offices as evacuation sites during the typhoon but this should be coordinated with University DRRMO for monitoring.
