In view of Tropical Depression "Kristine," all work and classes for the entire VSU system are suspended tomorrow morning, October 22, 2024. Work suspension will be lifted at 12:00 noon if weather conditions improve. However, classes in VSU Main Campus will remain suspended for the entire day, in accordance with OP Memorandum Circular No. 229 s. of 2024, which suspends classes during the 2024 Intramural Games.

Additionally, should the weather permit, the opening ceremony for the VSU Intramural Games will push through as scheduled in the afternoon. Please stay tuned for further announcements regarding the event.

The VSU Management Committee and the Crisis Management Committee urge everyone to take precautionary measures during this time. Stay indoors, avoid non-essential travel, and monitor official weather advisories. Make sure your homes are secure, and keep emergency supplies such as food, water, and medicine accessible. Dormitory occupants must also stay vigilant of the weather conditions, as well as those residing in low-lying or flood-prone areas, for potential evacuation notices.
