In view of the upcoming VSU Centennial Celebration, please be informed of the special traffic flow management plan to ensure smooth and orderly movement of vehicles and pedestrians during the event.

Specifically, please be guided with the following:


- 1. **Traffic rerouting:** Certain roads within and around the campus are temporarily closed for the event. Vehicles will be routed to alternate routes marked with signs. Detailed maps of the routing scheme have already been posted.
- Parking Areas: Designated parking areas are already established around the campus.
 All vehicles must be parked in these areas to avoid congestion and obstruction of traffic. Vehicles parked in non-designated areas will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Pedestrian Zones: Certain areas within the campus will be designated as pedestrianonly zones. No vehicles will be allowed in these areas.
- 4. **Traffic Marshals:** Traffic marshals are already deployed to manage traffic flow, enforce the traffic scheme, and assist attendees.
