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R E: Guidelines in the Review of Undergraduate Instruction


Please consider the following points in the review of undergraduate instruction:

1. Undergraduate instruction in ViSCA shall focus on sustainable agriculture as an art, science and a business.
2. The BSA curriculum shall remain the center-piece of ViSCA's curricular program.
3. Horticulture, Agronomy & Soils and Animal Science Departments shall compose the arrowhead of ViSCA's instructional units.
4. Curricular offering shall pay attention to quantity and quality of graduates for cost effectiveness.

With items 1-4 as guideposts coupled with ViSCA's mission, goals and objectives, the following areas should be looked into:

1. Viability of course offerings considering cost per student as a major factor.
2. Staff availability; strength and weaknesses
3. Availability and viability of projects for hands-on training
4. Availability and quality of classroom and laboratory facilities
5. Effectiveness of student services
  - a. Library
  - b. Housing
  - c. Recreational facilities
  - d. Extra-curricular activities
  - e. Guidance and counselling service
  - f. Student recruitment, retention and placement
