In view of the upcoming Commencement Exercises Celebration, please be informed of the special traffic flow management plan to ensure smooth and orderly movement of vehicles and pedestrian during the event.

Specifically, please be guided with the following:

## 1. Detailed Traffic Management Strategies

- The Main entrance and Exit of the upper campus will be used as both entrance paths upon entering the campus before the graduation ceremony begins to avoid congestion of vehicles along the road.
- The Nangka Avenue will temporarily serve as an exit way until the graduation ceremony begins.

## 2. Specified Parking zones and Designated Locations for Shuttle Services

- The Map has identified the allocated parking zones for different groups, including graduates, families, VIPs, faculties, and staff.
- Shuttle services are designated in the Market, Pavillion and near the ATM at the lower part of the campus to ferry our graduates and their family.

## 3. Signage and Communication Guidelines

- Provision of a Map for the traffic flow of the vehicles and the drop-off zone will be in front of the Gymnatorium before the call time. Nevertheless, beyond the call time, the drop-off zone will be at the intersection going to Gymnatorium and PCC.
- Security Guards are manning strategic locations to guide all visitors going to the gymnatorium.
