#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, SSU is a state university in Samar identified by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) to take the lead on its funded project in line with CHED's strategic plan and is also consistent with the principles outlined in Republic Act 10931, which aims to advance equality, accessibility, and global competitiveness within the education system of the Philippine

WHEREAS, SSU as a state university is mandated to conduct research and development/extension projects in-line with the thrust and program priorities of the University.

WHEREAS, SSU has research centers, faculty and personnel equipped with the expertise in research and resources that are crucial in supporting the CHED's initiative of empowering equity target students and enhancing their access and success in higher education.

WHEREAS, LNU, EVSU, BIPSU, PIT, ESSU, NWSSU, SLSU, UEP, and VSU are state universities in Region VIII which focuses on the development of human resources and providing the necessary inputs for production and growth in the region.

WHEREAS, LNU, EVSU, BIPSU, PIT, ESSU, NWSSU, SLSU, UEP, and VSU are committed to demonstrate abilities in fulfilling applicable statutory and regulatory requirements, with an overall focus on risk-based thinking and on customer satisfaction. These universities put premium on revitalized instruction, relevant extension, intensified research, optimized production, and expanded development initiatives.

WHEREAS, LNU, EVSU, BIPSU, PIT, ESSU, NWSSU, SLSU, UEP, and VSU are duty-bound to continual improvement recognizing changes as opportunities at hand. With the established Quality Management System as foundation and guide for actions to take further steps toward becoming the leading state University.

WHEREAS, the PARTIES acknowledge the significance of ensuring that all Filipinos have access to quality, accessible, and inclusive higher education.

WHEREAS, the PARTIES commit to implementing initiatives that will ensure that the deserving marginalized students are represented in higher education and be able to complete their studies.

WHEREAS, the PARTIES recognize the value of data-driven policies on inclusive higher education through this CHED-commissioned research.

WHEREAS, the PARTIES recognize that cooperation joined by a common goal to reinforce collaborative research could enhance scientific bases for developing policies and targeted interventions aimed at improving access and success of marginalized students.

WHEREAS, the PARTIES share a common goal of ensuring that all students, regardless of their socio-economic background, have equal access to quality education and achieve academic success.

# ARTICLE I OBJECTIVES

The general purpose of this MOA is to strengthen the technical cooperation of the **PARTIES** by:

- 1.1 Establishing the terms and conditions of the collaboration between SSU and LNU, EVSU, BiPSU, PIT, ESSU, NWSSU, SLSU, UEP, VSU in the conduct of the study;
  - 1.2 Defining the roles and responsibilities of each SUCs in the study;
  - 1.3 Ensuring the protection and welfare of study participants;
  - 1.4 Ensuring the ethical conduct of the study;
  - 1.5 Provision of complementary services needed in the study;
  - 1.6 Undertaking other cooperative activities as may be determined by the PARTIES.
  - 1.7 Promoting the dissemination and utilization of study results.

## ARTICLE II RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES

#### 2.1 The **PARTIES** shall:

- 2.1.1 Have shared responsibility to fulfill the terms and conditions of the agreement, to communicate effectively, to maintain transparency and accountability, and to work towards the achievement of their shared objectives.
- 2.1.2 Comply with all ethical and legal requirements in the conduct of the study, including obtaining approval from the Institutional Review Board (IRB) and ensuring the confidentiality of study participants.
- 2.1.3 Ensure that all study participants are fully informed of the study's purpose, procedures, and risks, and that they provide informed consent for their participation.
- 2.1.4 Work collaboratively to identify and address any issues or challenges that may arise during the course of the agreement, and to make necessary adjustments to ensure the successful completion of the study
- 2.1.5 Acknowledge each other's contribution in all publications and presentations arising from the study.
- 2.1.6 Acknowledge and agree that any and all confidential information shared between SSU and other parties during the course of this partnership shall be considered as confidential and shall not be disclosed to any third party without the express written consent of both Parties.

#### 2.2 The SSU shall:

- 2.2.1 Provide support and expertise for the conduct of the study, including research staff, necessary research materials, and orientation/training for focal persons.
- 2.2.2. Formalize the conduct of the study with the University President of the partner Universities and its assigned focal persons per campus.

- 2.2.3 Be responsible for collecting data from the focal person of the partner universities, monitoring the data collection process, and analyzing the data based on the objectives of the study.
- 2.2.4 Report study results to the other PARTIES and other stakeholders, as well as dissemination of findings through academic publications, conferences, or other means.
- 2.2.5 Appropriately acknowledge and credit the other PARTIES with the technical knowledge gained brought forth from agreements stated in this MOA; and

#### 2.2 The LNU, EVSU, BiPSU, PIT, ESSU, NWSSU, SLSU, UEP, and VSU shall:

- 2.2.1 Identify a focal person per campus to take the lead in the general data collection process. The assigned focal person shall:
  - 2.2.1.1 Comply with ethical guidelines and regulations, such as obtaining informed consent from study participants and protecting their privacy and confidentiality.
  - 2.2.1.2 Ensure effective communication and collaboration between different parties involved in the data collection process.
  - 2.2.1.3 Communicate regularly to the SSU project team regarding the progress of data collection and serve as a point of contact for addressing any problems or challenges that arise during the data collection process to ensure timely completion of the project.
  - 2.2.1.4 Conduct data gathering and FGDs including other necessary action for data gathering completion
  - 2.2.1.5 Encourage alumni, students, parents, faculties, and program chairs in the conduct of survey and FGDs.
  - 2.2.1.6 Be responsible for ensuring the completeness and accuracy of the information/data collected from the questionnaire.
- 2.2.2. Provide assistance and access to its facilities, resources, and information necessary for the conduct of the study, including its student records.
- 2.2.3 Allow the conduct of data collection activities, including interviews, with study participants.
- 2.2.4 Appropriately acknowledge SSU whenever results and findings from this MOA are presented in a public forum.
- 2.2.5 Keep in strict confidence any and all information that LNU, EVSU, BiPSU, PIT, ESSU, NWSSU, SLSU, UEP, and VSU had come to know from this MOA and shall not use any information gained for any purpose other than specifically stated in this MOA.

### ARTICLE III FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The PARTIES do not have any financial obligations to each other. However, SSU shall bear the responsibility for remunerating the LNU's, EVSU's, BiPSU's, PIT's, ESSU's, NWSSU's, SLSU's, UEP's, and VSU's assigned focal persons per campus by providing them with honoraria commensurate with their participation in the study and campus size in terms of student population. This ensures that the assigned focal persons are fairly compensated for

# ARTICLE IV INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS and PUBLICATION

All copyrights, industrial rights, intellectual property, and other intellectual property rights generated as a result of this MOA or in connection thereto and which are related to the STUDY are the properties of SSU and CHED.

The SSU and CHED has the exclusive right of exploitation of the aforementioned copyrights, industrial rights, intellectual property, and other intellectual property rights.

Before the publication of the research findings, both parties must agree on the authorship, attribution, and acknowledgement of contributions. They must also ensure that any intellectual property or confidential information is protected and used only for the purposes outlined in the agreement.

# ARTICLE V DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The parties shall, at all times, use their best efforts to resolve any dispute which may arise between them and under or in relation to this MOA amicably, in good health, with dispatch, with no Party resorting to public disclosure or ventilation of such differences. Any dispute or claims arising out of or from this MOA shall be settled by informal dispute proceedings, the process of which shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

## ARTICLE VI DURATION AND TERMINATION

This cooperation shall become effective upon signing by the PARTIES and shall continue in effect until PARTIES have fulfilled their obligations set forth in this MOA. Without prejudice to the term of the collaboration, a Party may terminate this MOA with immediate effect, if:

The other Party is in material default of any of its obligations under this MOA and the breach is of significant importance to the other Party.

If the other Party fails to comply with its obligations under this MOA and has not corrected its default, omission, or deficiency within four (4) weeks after the non-defaulting Party has given the defaulting Party written notice thereof.

In the event a complaint based on the MOA has not led to correction of an error or deficiency, the PARTIES shall, in addition, have the right, without separate obligation of compensation or refund, to suspend the MOA and terminate immediately in writing in the following circumstances:

If the PARTIES decide to terminate the MOA for scientific, ethical, or administrative reasons.
