

MEMORANDUM NO. 31 Series of 1987

- T O: All ViSCA Employees Concerned
- R E: Medical Allowance

As the most recent development, our President Corazon C. Aquino finally considered the appeal from various government sectors to grant medical allowance to other government agencies not covered by Executive Order 110. As provided under E.O. 147, medical allowance will now be given to all qualified employees. The amount necessary to implement this order shall come from the 1986 savings and from other sources in the government.

Therefore, the giving of medical allowances to qualified ViSCA employees will be done as soon as funds for the purpose are approved by the Department of Budget and Management inasmuch as all 1986 savings have been exhausted. All research leaders concerned must see to it that amounts are set aside for their personnel if their budget comes from "Other Services".

The provisions of Executive Order 147 are reproduced below:

SECTION 1. All national government agencies not covered by Executive Order No. 110 dated December 24, 1986, as well as government owned or controlled corporations are hereby authorized to make a one-time payment of medical allowance to their full-time regular and casual employees.

SECTION 2. The amount of said benefit shall be Two Thousand Pesos (F2,000) per employee.

SECTION 3. The benefits provided herein are payable only to those employed as of December 31, 1986 and who continue to be employed as of the date of the effectivity of this Executive Order.

SECTION 4. The medical allowance granted under this Executive Order as well as under Executive Order No. 110 dated December 24, 1986 shall only be limited to CY 1986 operations. Similar benefits for 1987 and future years, shall not be allowed, pending the results of a more comprehensive compensation study being done by the Department of Budget and Management.

SECTION 5. The amounts necessary to implement this Executive Order shall be taken from the aggregate savings in 1986 of the National Government. Any deficiency shall be charged against the Compensation and Organizational Adjustment Fund for 1987.

SECTION 6. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
