Severe tropical storm Odette internationally known as severe tropical storm Rai has entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility yesterday, December 14, 2021. PAGASA, in its latest weather update, has raised storm warning signal number 1 to several areas in Visayas and Mindanao, including the island of Leyte, Southern Leyte, and portions of Samar Island.

In order for us to make the necessary preparations for the possible landfall of "Odette" in our region, work and classes are suspended starting December 15, 2021, from 1:00 PM until December 16, 2021.
