
R E: Golden Snail ("Kuhol") and Fish Cultures and Other Backyard
Projects and Water Utilization on Campus

It has been observed that numerous ViSCA residents are presently engaged in various backyard projects such as golden snail ("Kuhol") and fish culture, poultry and piggery and other projects which draw water from the ViSCA water system. This has contributed to the depressing and continuing low pressure of water supply in many parts of the community. Some students have reported that water cannot go up anymore in the second and higher levels of the dormitories and other buildings, specially during peak hours.

In order to maintain the pressure and the supply of adequate water throughout the campus, including those at the second floor of buildings, we enjoin every ViSCA resident to refrain from leaving any water faucet open continuously any time of the day from 4:00 in the morning to 8:00 in the evening. Likewise, all residents and concerned ViSCA officials are requested to fix leaking faucets in their respective areas.

The cooperation of all concerned is urgently solicited, for obvious reasons. We can not afford to see some of our fellow ViSCAns suffer from inadequate supply of water while others lavishly use it.
