Sampling Technique: Stratified Random Sampling with Proportional Allocation

Sample sizes are allocated proportionately across campuses and degree programs. The proportion of sample size over number of graduates is constant across campuses and degree programs. (Proportion is approximately equal to 757/2604 but may actually differ due to rounding.)

Samples are **selected at random** within degree program in each campus. (Example: For DVM, 17 graduates will be selected at random from the 57 graduates of 2018 while for BSABE, 8 will be selected at random from the 28 graduates.)

Assumptions for Computing Sample Size:

Proportion Employed = 50%

Confidence Level = 95%

Margin of Error = 3%
