#### W. For Approval/Ratification/Confirmation 1 A. Academic Matters 2 1. A Proposal to offer Master of Agricultural Studies 3 In presenting the proposed Master of Agricultural 4 Studies, Pres. Bernardo apprised the Board that this is the 5 answer to the request of the heads of agricultural schools 6 in Regions VII and VIII that ViSCA should offer also a 7 non-thesis graduate degree program for those teachers 8 and/or employees of the government agencies in the Visayas 9 region who are involved in extension and/or community 10 development work. 11 Pres. Bernardo explained that the proposed masteral 12 degree program shall be mainly for those government 13 employees and/or teachers who will not be involved in 14 research work. He told the Board that after their lengthy 15 discussions on this matter, the ViSCA Academic Council 16 members adopted the said curricular proposal and named it 17 "Master of Agricultural Studies", a selection from five 18 possible names for the masteral degree program. 19 Hence, the recommendation of the College to offer the 20 "Master of Agricultural Studies", a non-thesis degree 21 program which offers specialization in the technical 22 (agricultural) field only. 23. In the deliberation that ensued, Hon. Felipe recalled 24

the Stanford model of development education at the graduate

level which embraces a wide field of disciplines to include

both the technical and social areas, which ViSCA may want to adopt. In view of this, the Board deferred action on the proposal to give ViSCA a chance to consider the Stanford 3 concept. 4 Regarding collegiate curricular offerings, Mr. Lindy 5 Morrell, Regional NEDA Director of Region VIII, suggested 6 that ViSCA should consider to offer bachelor courses that 7 prepare students along the lines of administering settlement 8 projects. He suggested two undergraduate courses, namely; 9 Bachelor of Science in Settlement Administration (BSSA) and 10 Bachelor of Agricultural Marketing (BSAgM). The regional 11 NEDA Director sees the need for graduates from such kind 12 of degree programs as a solution to the problems at 1.3 resettlement projects here in the island of Leyte and in 14 other neighboring provinces. 15 Hon. Felipe, on the other hand, finds it interesting 16 to see a degree program that would train people in urban 17 planning and sociology. 18 Pres. Bernardo thanked the Board for their suggestions 19 and promised to discuss them with the Ag. Dev. Ed. people 20 at ViSCA and possibly with UPLB. 21 Administrative Matters 22 1.
