Acting Chairman Suarez called the meeting to order at 4:50 p.m.

- 1 I. Approval of the Minutes of the 16th Regular Board Meeting. (March 3, 1977)
- The minutes of the 16th regular board meeting were confirmed
- 3 after the following corrections were made: (1) Page 2, first
- 4 line the word "elected" was changed to "chosen"; second

line - the phrase "approving the ViSCA Code" was corrected to "discussing the draft of the proposed VisCA Code for subsequent approval"; third and fourth lines -- the clause "the preparation of said code was pretty good" was corrected to "the code was, on the whole, well-prepared"; 7th line - the phrase "and section" was added after "each article"; line 2 - the phrase "15th regular" was inserted between "the" and "meeting". (2) Page 4, line 5 - the phrase "get back the construction cost of the staff housing" was corrected to "recover the construction costs of the staff houses"; line 17 - the phrase "in full" was added after "paid their lots"; line 18 "houses" was corrected to "own residences"; line 21 -- "if they have their own lots and houses" was corrected to "if they own the lots and houses in which they reside"; (3) Page 5, lines 7 and 8 - the phrase "as the request was almost standard" was corrected to "as the requested rate was standard"; line 10 -- the phrase "Approving authority for" was changed to "Authorizing"; line 14 -- the paragraph title was corrected to read; "Request of Mr. Nathaniel B. Barilea and Miss Erlinda Olan to Collect Stipend and Book Allowance as is Provided for Regular ViSCA Fellows; line 16 - the word "old" was deleted; line 17 -- the phrase "they were" was changed to "being"; the phrase "thet was why" was deleted; line 19 -- the phrase "on their salary without other privileges" was changed to "on their own sans ViSCA

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fellowship privileges"; line 23 -- "of" was inserted between "knowing" and "the high cost"; line 24 --"individuals" was inserted after "two"; (4) Page 6, line 2 -- "Approving the request of" was change to "Authorizing": line 3 -- "for" was deleted and "to collect" was inserted after Olan; Line 5 -- the phrase "as : provided" was inserted before "for regular CLSCA fellows": line 12 the word "respective"was added after "their"; (5) Page 9. lines 3 and 4 - the phrase "who do not make it or" was deleted and lines 5 and 6 - the phrase "subject to approval by the College Council" was also deleted; line 12the phrase "bas not budgeted for" was corrected to "had not been, included in the budget"; line 24 -- the paragraph title was corrected to read "Mequest for a Change of Status of Appointment of the Architectural Staff from Regular to Contractual"; (6) Page 11, lines 14 - 18 the Board recommended that other cooperators of the Philippine Farmers! Institute and their respective roles also be included. Thus, the following statements should be included on line 15, after the word program; "and would be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the institute; the Governor of Leyte who would provide the scholarship funds of 1/2.5 million annually; the Department of Public Highways, which would be responsible for the construction of roads and bridges; the Bureau of Public Works and the Provincial Engineer's Office which would be responsible for the construction of buildings and the campus site development;

1	the Leyte Sab-a Basin Development Authority, which
2	would provide the campus and farm site of about 1000
3	hectares; the Department of Education and Culture and fire
4	Office of the Provincial Agriculturist which would be
5	responsible for recruiting students and trainess,
6	the Bureau of Agricultural Extension which would look
7	after the employment of graduates; the Department of Local
8	Governments and Community Development which would follow up
9	the graduates; and the Department of Health which would provid
10	the medical dental staff. (7) Page 12, line 7—the word
11	"further" was inserted between "needed" and "editing";
12	line 13, Chapter 15 was corrected to 19.
13	II. Matters Arising from the Approved Minutes:
14	An inquiry was made regarding the status of Board .
15	Resolution No. 13, s. 1977 - Request of the College
16	President for allotment of lump-sum appropriation
17	through a supplemental special budget in the amount of
18	73,340,550.00 for the implementation of the Philippine
19	Farmers! Institute project. President Bernardo answered
20	that a copy was sent to Commissioner J. C. Laya and another
21	was sent to Chairman Tantuico who will follow up the request.
22	It was recommended that the President make brief status
23	reports on previous board resolution and that this should be
24	included in the agenda of every meeting.
25	III. Academic Matters:
26	A. The proposed exprimental rural high school curricula
27	tions discussed at great length by the heard Progident

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Bernardo explained that although the curricula adopted
some of the features of the Philippine Science High
School, they are in a way, different, as the thrust of
the ViSCA Experimental Rural High School is towards
agricultural science (teaching science with a strong bias
towards agriculture) and rural development (harnessing the
resources found in the rural areas).
On motion duly seconded, the Board passed:
BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 14. s. 1977
Approving the proposed experimental rural
high school curricula for the four-year agricultural

Approving the proposed experimental rural high school curricula for the four-year agricultural science, vocational homemaking and vocational agriculture secondary courses.

B. The Board went over the proposed two-year curriculum for the Agro-Research-Extension Technician's course. President Bernardo explained that the curriculum is at the post-secondary level with innovations to accommodate those who have not graduated from high school but with at least four years of farming experience. The curriculum is intended for out-of-school youth and farmer-leaders who will later provide leadership in the community.

The Board suggested: (1) the inclusion in the curriculum of some subjects in economics and some elective subjects to provide flexibility; and (2) the giving of unit equivalents to experience.

On motion duly seconded, the Board passed:

BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 15, s. 1977

1	Approving the two-year curriculum for the
2	agro-research-extension technician course and
3	referring it back to the committee for possible
4	inclusion of its recommendations.
5	IV. The ViSCA Code
6	From page 49, Chapter 19, to page 59, Chapter 27,
7	Article 249, the Board discussed the draft of the
8	proposed ViSCA Code and made corrections and suggestions.
9	The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
10	April 2, 1977 - Resumption of the Discussion of the ViSCA Code.
11	The discussion of the proposed Code was resumed
12	starting from 8:25 a.m. to 12:15 p.m., and from 3:00 to
13	3:35 p.m. covering chapters 27-59, pages 59 - 88. Since
14	the Board failed to discuss the rest of the Code, the
15	approval of the Code was deferred to the next regular
16	Board meeting.
17	As the Board members were going to attend the
18	commencement exercises at 4:00 p.m., the meeting was
19	adjourned at 3:35 p.m.
